- *The Summer Term will end on Friday, July 3, 2020.*
- Due to Covid-19 restrictions, there will be no Summer School this year.
- Registration for the new school year will take place from August 24 27, 2020 from 8:30 a.m. 3:00 p.m. each day. Please be aware that accommodation in classes will only be made for students who are fully registered.
- There will be an increased in school fee for the new school year as follows:
